You can clearly see a small quantity of white material that has settled into the corners of the envelope warning you that the contents are not that of a simple letter.

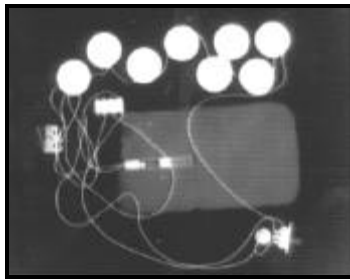

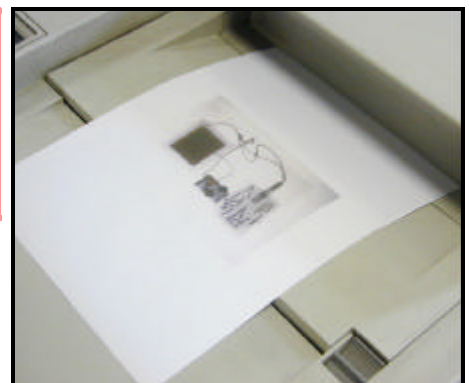

in staff training and to develop recognition skills in new and temporary personnel.

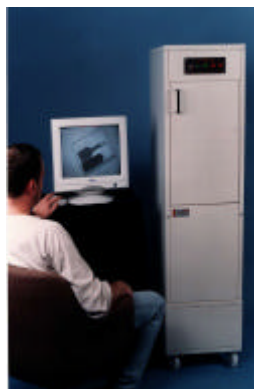

BIGGER NOT ALWAYS BETTER, CONVEYOR BOMB RISKS EXPOSED

Recent reports confirm that airport security in the wake of September 11th is worse than it was 30 years ago!

It is claimed screening staff failed to detect 70% of knives, 60% of fake bombs and 30% of guns which were smuggled through conveyor x-ray machines by undercover inspectors. In similar tests undertaken 30 years ago only 20% of weapons could be sneaked through.
